

Beijing +10:

Kampanje mot bruk av voldtekt som våpen i Burma

Flere organisasjoner har lansert en underskriftskampanje under FNs kvinnekommisjon i New York, hvor de fremmer internasjonale krav for å bedre situasjonen for kvinner i Burma. Kommisjonen markerer i disse dager at det er 10 år siden handlingsplanen om kvinner og likestilling ble vedtatt i Beijing. Den norske Burmakomite støtter opp om kravene.

Tekst med krav fra kampanjen:

To all women dedicated to freedom and democracy

Around the world, women are suffering for their public engagements and especially, when they struggle for a democratic system against bloody dictatorships. Around of the world, too many woman are victims of violence, threats, and too many are abused or raped.

Around of the world, women have to show and express solidarity with her comrades from Burma, victims of a barbarian military regime that use rapes as a weapon of war to diminish power and humiliate ethnic minority groups in struggle for democracy and human rights for all burmese citizens.

Around of the world, women have to make unity and alliances in order to achieve the immediate, unconditionnal and definitive released of Daw Aung San Suu Kyi under house arrest for more than 9 years. Around of the world, women want by signing this text to express their concern about the current situation inside Burma. This petition aims to criticize ASEAN countries permitting to let intimate Myanmar/Burma rulers by chairmanship in 2006.

By signing this text, I express my concern for:

- End military rulers to use rape as a weapon of war in Burma
- Daw Aung San Suu Kyi immediate, unconditionnal and definitive released from house arrest
- No SPDC chairmanship of ASEAN in 2006
